## AIS Special Interest Group on Education (SIGED) International Conference

Researchers/Educators are invited to submit their original work related to the education theme of the conference. Submissions describing the following and any other related topics are encouraged:

- AI-Driven Personalization in Student Learning
- Chatbots as Academic Advisors
- Enhancing Student Engagement through AI Tools
- Ethical Considerations in AI-Enhanced Education
- AI and Inclusive Education
- Assessment and Feedback through AI
- Blended Learning: Integrating AI with Traditional Classroom Methods
- Leveraging AI to assist students with career planning, internships, and professional development
- Student Data Analytics and AI for Institutional Improvement
- AI and Curriculum Development
- Educating students about the United Nations Sustainability Development Goals using AI
- AI for Cybersecurity in Education
- ESG (Environment, Social and Governance) and AI collaborations in education
- Future Trends in AI use for Student-Centered Learning.

**Submissions may be in one of the following forms:**

- **Completed Research Paper.** An original paper that has not been published elsewhere. The submission should be maximum 6000 words and must include an abstract (150-word max) along with the body of the full paper. The reference list and appendices (if any) are excluded from the word count.
- **Research in Progress Paper.** A submission of original work which is substantially near completion. The submission should be at least 2500 words in length, and must include an abstract.

- **Opinion or Discussion Paper.** A submission that focuses on issues related to the theme of the conference. The opinions expressed in these papers should be well-developed and, where appropriate, supported by evidence, while keeping in mind that these are opinion pieces rather than traditional research papers.
- **Descriptive Case study.** A submission that reports specific pedagogical or curricular strategies being employed or under development. The submission should not be longer than 6000 words.
- **Proposal for a Panel Discussion or Tutorial.** A proposal to offer a panel discussion or a tutorial on a topic related to the theme of the conference. The submission must include the names and affiliations of panellists who have agreed to participate, a 1-2-page summary of the topic and a structure of how the session will be presented.

#### Submission guidelines:

- Submissions in Rich Text or Microsoft Word file formats, should be submitted via the OpenConf Submission System: <http://iciser.informatiemanagement.org/openconf.php>.
- **All submissions will be double-blind peer reviewed** and notifications will be emailed to the contact author.
- All submissions will be checked for plagiarism.
- Where authors use AI and AI-assisted technologies in the writing process, these technologies should only be used to improve readability and language of the work.
- For accepted submissions, authors must submit a final version addressing any comments received from reviewers. This should include author details, must adhere to required formatting style and guidelines as described in the 2024 AIS-SIGED-Submission-Guidelines (available on the SIGED website), and should be submitted via the Submission System by the Publication Ready Revision Deadline.

Papers, panels and tutorials accepted for the conference will only be **published in the conference proceedings if at least one author and all members of the panels and tutorials register for the conference by the Author Registration Deadline and present their work during the conference.** Conference proceedings appear in the AIS eLibrary and are indexed by Scopus and other databases.

#### Awards:

Papers judged by the review process to be candidates for the '**Best Paper**' award will be forwarded for an additional Best Paper Candidate review process. The top ranked paper(s) will be recognized during the conference 'best paper' award presentation. Please note, the papers which exceed the word limit will not be considered for the Best Paper Award.

A '**Best Reviewer**' award will be selected after examining all reviews. The reviewer should have demonstrated the expertise to provide insightful and knowledgeable feedback, should have provided quality reviews which are helpful to the authors of papers, should have displayed collegiality and constructive feedback, and should have completed reviews on time.
